## NCL scientist gets CSIR award

NATIONAL Chemical Laboratory (NCL), Pune, scientist Sanjay P Kamble has been conferred the CSIR Young Scientist Award for 2010 in Engineering Sciences. Kamble was honoured for his contribution to the development of chemical processes and technologies to protect environment and minimise energy consumption. The award was given during the 68th CSIR Foundation Day function held recently in Delhi. He is also a past recipient of Innovative Projects Student Award and Gujarat Ambuja Cement Best PhD (Tech) Thesis Award of The Indian National Academy of Engineering, Delhi, and Institute of Chemical Technology, Mumbai, respectively. "He has made pioneering contribution to photocatalysis for environmental applications / defluorination of water, besides research on chemical processes for vinyl esters, lactic acid etc," an NCL spokesman stated. He has published more than 20 research papers and has four patents to his credit. The award consists of a citation, a plaque and a cash prize, besides start-up research support.

## Largest recreation park now at Lonavla

**Pune:** Integrated design and building company Della Technica Group announced the launch of 'Della Adventure', the country's largest recreation park spread across 36 acres in Kuneegaon, Lonavla at an investment of Rs 200 crore, including cost of land.

Della Technica Group, MD and Principal Architect Jimmy Mistry said on Wednesday that Della Adventure will have a 10-acre adventure park, and residential villas across the remaining 26 acres surrounded by lush greenery. The project is being executed in two phases, of which the 10-acre adventure park is open to public now.

'Della Adventure' has over 86 activities, including 42 adventure and 29 hobby activi-

ties. The park has the Flying Fox - India's longest permanent 500-foot zip line, tarzan swing 40 ft high rope activity, world's largest All Terrain Vehicle Polaris Ranger 800 cc, the country's first permanent public track for dirt bike racing, night rappelling and zorbing etc, said Mistry.

The park also has a luxury resort with multi-cuisine restaurants offering Indian, Mediterranean and Pan-Asian cuisines, banqueting facility for up to 1,500 guests, music lounge etc. It is operational all days, and has packages starting from Rs 1,000 onward for individuals, families and corporates. Mistry added, "The park is expecting over one million visitors a year. We plan to replicate this next in Goa, followed by Indore and will cover 30 cities in the coming years."
